Europe is expert in FWD!

Sample of European activities:

- 9 European FWD Users' Group Meetings (2001 2019)
- 10th Euro FWD UGM is upcoming
- COST action 336 (1996 2000, revision of final report in 2005)
- 3 FeHRL workshops on FWD (FeHRL working group: 1991 1996)
- Comparative tests in Europe:
 - Nowadays in NL (CROW), UK (TRL), F (STAC), D (BASt)
 - Various test trials in Europe since 1987 (if not earlier)
- UK+Ireland FWD Users' Group and their meetings
- Some regulatory or descriptive national documents exist

Why a website for Euro FWD UG?

Visibility:

- Hard to find info on previous EuroFWD UG Meetings,
- final report of COST action 336 cannot be found,
- UK+Ireland FWD Users' Group (disappeared from the web),
- Lots of European documents are hidden on the web.

At this moment on the website:

- 9 European FWD Users' Group Meetings (2001 2019)
 - Announcements for this meeting
 - Programmes of all 9 meetings
 - Link to existing pages (sometimes with presentations, abstracts)
- COST action 336: "final report" (version 2005)
- FeHRL Report "harmonisation of FWD measurements and data processing for flexible road pavement evaluation" (1996)

Will be added:

announcement of 10th meeting



Could be added:

- More existing documents:
 - Links?
 - Physical copy of the document?
- More articles on:
 - Past comparative days,
 - Past meetings (e.g. FeHRL workshops of last century).
- Announcements for events organized by others?
 - e.g. future comparative days, future events
- Articles (descriptions) on related organisations:
 - e.g. US FWD UG, FWD UG in Japan
 - e.g. DaRTS group, Curviameter workshop(s)

Host and look


As neutral as possible:

- Neutral names for the link to the website (both work):
 - http://www.fwdug.eu/
 - http://www.eurofwdug.eu/
- Logo of the European FWD Users' Group
- Clearly stated that it is the website of the EuroFWD UG

However:

- BRRC hosts the website (no costs asked for)
- Style is as a "BRRC website" (colours, some BRRC logo)
- For some reason the neutral address disappears and becomes:
 - http://eurofwdug.brrc.be/
- At first, a bit complicated for downloading of documents

How to organise?

Current content:

- I put some things on the site.
- Some input from a few people only.
- Careful about "copyright" and the appropriate "references".
- Access to documents (in pdf) only for "members".

Become a "member" of the website:

- Go to BRRC website www.brrc.be/en
- 2. Log on (once) to the BRRC website
- Go back to http://www.eurofwdug.eu/
- 4. Log on (once) to the EuroFWD UG website for activation of your membership for that website.

Once a "member":

In order to download a document, just log on to the EuroFWD UG website. (You will never have to go back to the BRRC website.)

How to organise?

Future additional content:

- Can we decide here what kind of information should be made available on the website?
 - More existing documents: duplicates of presentations at previous meetings, duplicates of national documents, access to conference papers,...?
 - Texts on things other than the EuroFWDUGM, hence organized by others?
 - Announcements of initiatives by others (with link to original announcements)?
- Call for contributions from all of you:
 - Articles (text)
 - Documents (physical copy or link), preferably with a few lines about the context

• I can modify content, as long as it is a minor management task.







Access documents as a member: procedure


1. Click "Log in"



2. Log in




3. Go and get the document
